1) Picture, Photo or Object

Bring in anything that inspires you, whether it's an image cut from a magazine, a special photo or an object that you are drawn to that you would like to paint.

2) Paints

You can substitute any red, blue, yellow, magenta, black and white and/or use these specific colors:

Titanium White

Burnt Sienna

Burnt Umber

Cadmium Red and/or Alizarin Crimson

Yellow Ochre and/or Cadmium Yellow Light

Ultramarine Blue and/or Cerulean Blue

Quinacridone Red

3) Brushes

Large, medium and small. Any variety and quantity that includes both flat and round bristles. Synthetic.

4) Canvas

Any size you prefer. Must be a primed, gallery wrapped canvas.

5) Plastic Palette

To hold and mix your paint. Can use anything from waxed paper plates, glass, disposable palettes to a "stay wet" palette.

6) Container

A glass or jar that you will put water in to clean off your brushes while painting.

7) HB Graphite Pencil

8) Kneaded Eraser

Optional but recommended:

Matte or Gloss Medium

Color Wheel

Palette knives

Paper towels

Spray bottle filled with water
